Where do I find the Health Care Information for my students?

Information about the health status of your students can be found on the intranet. Simply click on the red link “**Emergency Health Care Information**” which can be found at the top of the ‘Important links’ section on the far right hand side of your screen.



Choose the relevant Management Group and then the required qualification.
